#### NOTIFICATION

The 30th September, 1998

No. GSR 42/H.A./16/1994/98. - In exercise of the powers conferred by Subsection (2) of Section 67 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act. 1994 (Haryana Act 16 of 1994), the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules regulating the recruitment and conditions of service of the members appointed to the Haryana Municipal Corporation Employees (Recruitment and Conditions) Service, namely :-

#### Part I

#### General

- Short title and commencement (1) These rules may be called the Haryana Municipal Corporation Employees (Recruitment and Conditions) Service Rules, 1998.
  - (2) These rules are applicable to the employees of the Municipal Corporations in Haryana.
  - (3) These rules shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Definitions In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, -
  - "Act" means the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 (Haryana Act 16 of 1994);
  - (b) "direct recruitment" means an appointment made otherwise than by promotion from within the Service or by transfer of an official already in the service of Government of India or any State Government;
  - (c) "Director" means the Director of Land Records;
  - (d) "institution" means, -
    - any institution established by law in force in the State of Harvana; or
    - (ii) any other institution recognised by the Government for the purpose of these rules;

- e) "recognised university" means, -
  - (i) any University incorporated by law in India; or
  - in the case of a degree, diploma or certificate obtained as a result of examination held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab, Sind or Dacca University; or
  - (iii) any other university which is declared by the Government to be recognised university for the purpose of these rules;
- "Secretary" means the Financial Commissioner, Commissioner and Secretary to Government in the Local Government Department;
- (g) "Service" means the Haryana Municipal Corporation Employees (Recruitment and Conditions) Service;
- (h) "Selection Committee" means the committee consisting of the following members.-
  - (a) in case of posts where Government is the appointing authority, -

(1)	Secretary to Government Haryana, Local Government Department	Chairman
(ii)	Commissioner	Members
(iii)	two other officers of the Government to be co- opted by the Members	Chairman

(b) in case of posts where Commissioner is the appointing authority,-

(I) Commissioner	Chairman
(ii) Senior most Joint Commissioner, Municipal Corporation	Members
(iii) a representative of Deputy Commissioner	Member
(iv) another locally appointed Government Officer to be Co-opted by the Chairman	Member

 words and expressions used in these rules but not defined, and defined in the Act, shall have the meaning respectively assigned in the Act itself.

#### Part II

#### Recruitment to Service

Number and character of posts. - The Service shall comprise the posts shown in Appendix A to these rules:

Provided that nothing in these rules shall affect the inherent right of the Government to make additions to, or reductions in the number of such posts or to create new posts with different designations and scales of pay, either

- 4. Nationality, domicile and character of candidates appointed to Service . -
  - No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service, unless he is, -
  - a citizen of India; or (a)
  - a subject of Nepal; or
  - a subject of Bhutan; or
  - a person of Indian origin, who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka or any of the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda and United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethiopia with Intention of permanently settling in India:

Provided that a candidate belonging to any of the categories (b), (c) or (d) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government.

- (2) A person in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the recruiting authority but the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government.
- (3) No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service by direct recruitment, unless he produces a certificate of character from the Principal Academic Officer of the University, college, school or institution last attended, if any, and similar certificate from two other responsible persons, not being his relatives, who are well-acquainted with him in his private life and are unconnected with his University, college, school or Institution.
- 5. Age. No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service by direct recruitment if he is less than 17 years or more than 25 years of age, on the last date of submission of application to the appointing authority.
- 6. Appointing authority. Appointment to the posts in the Service shall be made by the authorities mentioned in column number 3 of Appendix C to the rules, as recommended by Selection Committee, appointment in the case of direct recruitment will be made on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
- 7. Qualifications. No person shall be appointed to any post in the Service, unless he is in possession of qualification and experience specified in column 3 of Appendix B to these rules in case of direct recruitment and those specified in column 4 of the aforesaid Appendix in the case of persons appointed other than by direct recruitment:

Provided that in case of appointment by direct recruitment, the qualifications regarding experience shall be relexable to the extent of 50 per cent at the discretion of the recruiting authority in case sufficient number of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and physically handicapped categories, possessing the requisite experience, are not

available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them after recording reasons for so doing in writing.

#### 8. Disqualifications. - No person, -

- who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spause living; or
- who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any post in the Service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

The 'pass' certificate issued by HARTRON or any other agency, as approved by the Government, would be accepted as an evidence of the fulfilment of the prescribed condition in the Service Rules.

- (4) The syllabus for the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) would contain Word Processing, Internet Browsing and Email management only.
- (5) In the case of Clerks, typing speed of 30 words per minute in English and 25 words per minute in Hindi converted with equivalent key depressions in both cases as the typing speed, would be tested on computers.
- (6) The employees possessing the following qualifications are exempted from taking the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC):—
  - M.Tech/B.Tech (Computers), MCA, BCA or Diploma in Computers from the recognized institutions e.g. Polytechnics;
  - Basic Computer Literacy Certificate from any recognized centre established under the National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT) [erstwhile DOEACC Society];
  - Haryana State Certificate in Information Technology [HS-CIT] from the Authorized Learning Centres (ALCs) of the HKCL;
  - (iv) Candidates/employees who have already passed the SETC and the same is valid at the time of joining the service. The State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) passed by any candidate earlier shall be considered valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of such certificate by HARTRON or any other agency authorized by the Government; and
  - (v) Physically disabled candidates i.e. amputation of hand (Left and Right) Amputation of upper limbs, Paralysis of Radial Nerve (Radial Nerve Palsy) of either upper limb. 10. Probation. - (1) Persons appointed to any post in the Service shall remain on probation for a period of two years, if appointed by direct recruitment, and one year, if appointed otherwise:

- (b) any period of work in equivalent or higher rank, prior to appointment to any post in the Service, may, in the case of an appointment by transfer, at the discretion of the appointing authority, be allowed to count towards the period of probation fixed under this rule; and
- (c) any period of officiating appointment shall be reckoned as period spent on probation, but no person who has so officiated shall, on the completion of the prescribed period of probation, be entitled to be confirmed, unless he is appointed against a permanent vacancy.
- (2) If, in the opinion of the appointing authority, the work or conduct of a person during the period of probation is not satisfactory, it may -
  - (a) If such person is appointed by direct recruitment, dispense with his services, and
  - (b) If such person is appointed otherwise than by direct recruitment, -
  - (i) revert him to his former post; or
  - (ii) deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of the previous appointment permit.
- (3) On the completion of the period of probation of a person, the appointing authority may,
  - (a) if his work and conduct has, in its opinion, been satisfactory, -
    - confirm such person from the date of his appointment if appointed against a permanent vacancy; or
    - confirm such person from the date from which a permanent vacancy occurs, if appointed against a temporary vacancy; or
    - declare that he has completed his probation satisfactorily, if there is no permanent vacancy; or
  - (b) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been not satisfactory, -
    - dispense with his services, if appointed by direct recruitment, if appointed otherwise, revert him to his former post or deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of previous appointment permit; or
    - (ii) extend his period of probation and thereafter pass such order, as it could have passed on the expiry of the first period of probation:

Provided that the total period of probation, including extension, if any, shall not exceed three years.

11. Seniority. - Seniority inter se of members of the Service shall be determined by the length of continuous service on any post in the service :

Provided that where there are different cadres in the Service, the seniority shall be determined separately for each cadre:

Provided further that in the case of a member appointed by direct recruitment, the order of merit determined by the appointing authority shall not be disturbed in fixing the seniority:

Provided further that in the case of two or more members appointed on the same date, their seniority shall be determined as follows:-

- (a) a member appointed by direct recruitment shall be senior to a member appointed by promotion or by transfer;
  - a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a member appointed by transfer;
  - (c) in the case of members appointed "by promotion or by transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such members in the appointments from which they were promoted or transferred; and
  - (d) in the case of members appointed by transfer from different cadres, their seniority shall be determined according to pay, preference being given to a member, who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment, and if the rates of pay drawn are also the same, then by the length of their service in the appointments and if the length of such service is also the same, the older member shall be senior to the younger member.
- 12. Liability to serve. [(1) A member of the Service shall be liable to serve at any place, in any Municipal Corporation in the State of Haryana, on being ordered so to do by the appointing authority '[or the State Government].]<sup>2</sup>
- (2) A member of Service may also be deputed to serve as under: (i) a company, an association or a body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the State Government, a Municipal Corporation or Municipal Council or Municipal Committee or a local authority or University <sup>3</sup>[or any other department of the State Government] within the State of Haryana;
  - the Central Government or a company, an association or a body of individuals, whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the Central Government; or
  - (iii) any other State Government, an international organisation, an autonomous body not controlled by the Government or a private body.

13. Pay, Leave, pension and other matters. - (1) In respect of pay, leave, pension

and all other matters, not expressly provided for in these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by such rules and regulations as may have been, or may hereafter be, adopted or made by the competent authority under the Constitution of India or under any law for the time being in force made by the State Legislature.

- (2) Faridabad Complex Employees Pension and General Provident Fund Rules, 1992 shall be applicable to all the employees of the Municipal Corporation.
- (3) In respect of leave, travelling allowance, joining time, suspension, medical facilities fees, honoraria, house rent allowance, fixation of pay, grant of increment, crossing of efficiency bar, deputation and other matters not expressly provided in these rules, members of service shall be governed by Civil Services Rules mutatis mutandis are applicable to Haryana Government employees from time to time.
- 14. Discipline, penalties and appeals. (1) In matters relating to discipline, penalties and appeals members of the Service shall be governed by the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeals) Rules, 1987, as amended from time to time:

Provided that nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and the appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under Article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as are specified in Appendix C to these rules.

- (2) The authority competent to pass an order under Clause (c) or Clause (d) of Sub-rule (1) of Rule 9 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987 and appellate authority shall be as specified in Appendix D to these rules.
- 15. Vaccination. Every member of the Service shall get himself vaccinated and re-vaccinated as and when the Government so directs by a special or general order.
- 16. Oath of allegiance. Every member of the Service, unless he has already done so, shall be required to take an oath of allegiance to India and to the Constitution of India as by law established.
- 17. Power of relaxation. Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 18. Special provision. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the appointing authority may impose special terms and conditions in the order of appointment if it is deemed expedient to do so.
- 19. Reservations. Nothing contained in these rules shall effect reservations and others concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen, Physically Handicapped persons or any other class or

20. Repeal and savings. - Any rule applicable to the Service and corresponding to any these rules, which is in force immediately before the commencement of these rules, is hereby repealed:

Provided that any order made or action taken under the rule so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

# (COMMUNICATION AND CONNECTIVITY INFRASTRUCTURE) BYE-LAWS 2013

#### Notification

The 03rd October, 2013

No.2/12/2013/RF2.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 392 read with Section 393 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act. 1994 (Act 16 of 1994), and with reference to Haryana Government, Urban Local Bodies Department, notification No. 2/12/2013/R2 dated the 2nd September, 2013, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following Bye-laws, namely:—

#### BYE-LAWS

- Short title and commencement.- (i) These bye-laws may be called as the haryana Municipal Corporation (Communication and Connectivity Infrastructure) Bye-laws, 2013.
  - (ii) They shall come into force at1 once.
- 2. Definitions.- In these bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires-
  - (a) "Act" means the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act. 1994 (Act 16 of 1994);
  - (b) "Appendix" means Appendix appended with these bye-laws;
  - (c) "applicant" means communication infrastructure provider registered with the Department of Telecommunications, Government of India or any telecom service provider licensed from the Department of Telecommunications, Government of India, to lay the communication and connectivity infrastructure and eligible to seek licence under these bye-laws;
  - (d) "arrears" means the amount an applicant is liable to pay to the State Development Agency for communication infrastructure laid/erected before the notification of these bye-laws;
  - (e) "cable" means an assembly of one or more insulated conductors or optical fibres or a combination of both, within an enveloping jacket which may be underground or overhanging and is a high speed physical medium for transmitting data/information;
  - "communication infrastructure" includes dish antenna, optical fibre cable. Ground Based Mast, Roof Top Mast, mobile/communication
