Subject: Policy regarding grant of extension of time in the cases pertaining to permission for construction of shopping malls, multiplexes and Town Planning Schemes.

Please refer to the matter cited as subject.

2. After careful consideration, Government has decided to consider grant of extension of time after validity period, for construction of shopping malls & multiplexes permitted under the policy notified on 16.09.2005. subject to the payment of additional fee as mentioned below. Further, it is also decided to charge additional fee while granting extension of time for Town Planning Schemes:-

1. Extension of time for construction of Shopping Malls :

The extension of time for two-years from the validity period shall be allowed subject to payment of 10% of the licence fee to be charged at the rate prevailing at the time of grant of extension;


2. Extension of time for construction of Multiplexes :

The extension for another three-years from validity period shall be allowed subject to the payment of scrutiny fee and conversion charges to be charged at the rate prevailing at the time of grant of extension;

3. Extension of time for execution of TP Schemes :

The extension of time for two-years from the validity period as provided under Section 203 of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and Section 267 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994, shall be allowed subject to the payment of 10% of the licence fee to be charged at the rate prevailing at the time of grant of extension;

However such permissions shall be granted after obtaining the approval of the Government.
