Please refer to your office letter memo Nos. MCR/SAO/2023/02 dated 11.04.2023 and MCR/SAO/2023/10 dated 20.04.2023 on the subject cited above.

2. The sanction of Government is accorded to the Municipal Corporation, Rohtak (MCR) Budget for Financial Year (F.Y.) 2023-24 as follows:-

- 3. Government has granted this sanction under section 83 (3) of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 with the following conditions:-
 - (a) As per the provisions of sub-section (1) & (2) of section 83 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994, every Municipal Corporation has to submit the Budget Estimate for next financial year to the Government upto the last week of February of every year so that timely sanction of the Budget can be accorded by the Government. As such Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall ensure timely submission of Budget Estimate to the Government, as per the provisions of the Act, in future.
 - (b) The powers of Collector have been delegated under Haryana Land Revenue Act, 1887 to Commissioners & District Municipal Commissioners as also the powers of Assistant Collector Grade-I to District Municipal Commissioners, Additional Commissioners, Additional Municipal Commissioners & Joint Commissioners and Assistant Collector Grade-II to Deputy Municipal Commissioners, Executive Officers, Secretaries and Zonal Taxation Officers.

However, the recovery of Property Tax has not improved during the previous financial year 2022-23 to the expected level. Therefore, concerted efforts need to be made for recovery of atleast 90% of the outstanding Property Tax during the current financial year,

(c) Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall exhort all the concerned staff to put in maximum efforts for recovery of arrears as well as due amounts of Municipal taxes, charges and fees etc. so as to achieve the targets of Budget Estimate for the current Financial Year 2023-24.

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- (d) Municipal Corporation, Rohtak should take all necessary steps to arrange land management by ensuring maximum monetization of municipal land after following due procedures.
- (e) It is observed that as on date out of total 458 applications, zero have been rejected and 161 approved by the Municipal Corporation, Rohtak for disposal of municipal shops/houses let out on lease/rent/licence fee/tehbazari for 20 years or more under Mukhyamantri Shehri Nikay Swamitva Yojana.

Municipal Corporation, Rohtak needs to put in maximum efforts to ensure the disposal of all pending cases by 31st May, 2023. The amount of proceeds be kept under a separate Head and utilize as per the Policy provisions in this regard.

of street lights as well as office buildings including tubewells, sewerage treatment plants etc. are paid timely as it has been noticed that due to non payment of these bills, huge penalties have been imposed by DISCOM. Further, monthly meetings should be held with the concerned officers of DHBVN for adjustment of electricity bills with municipal tax and after netting, the amount due to or receivable from DHBVN should be released accordingly.

Furthermore, Property Tax dues on DISCOM properties need to be recovered/adjusted timely during the respective financial year itself. Any laxity in this regard shall be treated seriously.

Instructions in this regard have already been circulated vide this office memo No. DULB/Tax/2022/17987 dated 27.04.2022 in compliance of the decisions taken during the meeting held under the Chairpersonship of PSCM on 20.04.2022 and should be followed in letter & spirit. Any laxity in this regard shall be viewed seriously.

- (g) The amounts parked in Fixed Deposits (FDs) should be invested properly as per the Government instructions to ensure maximum returns.
- (h) It shall also be ensured that no expenditure should be incurred beyond the approved/sanctioned Budget estimate for Financial Year 2023-24.
- (i) Grants-in-aid should be utilized for those purposes only for which these grants have been sanctioned and utilized during the stipulated period. There should be no diversion in utilization of these grants.
- (j) Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall make all the expenditure for execution of development works out of its own income during F.Y. 2023-24.
- (k) In order to provide better facilities for payment of various municipal dues by the public, adequate number of CFCs (to be named as Atal Sewa Kendra (ASK)) be established at different locations within the limits of MC, Rohtak as per the criteria of one CFC per 15,000 population. This will also push the recovery of Property Tax & Water Charges etc.

As this is part of the Budget Speech for F.Y. 2023-24 of Hon'ble Chief Minister, the progress regarding establishment of these CFCs (ASK) be



- Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall expedite the process of regularization of un-authorized and the Government be strictly un-authorized colonies and timelines given by the Government be strictly adhered to in the (1)adhered to in this regard. This will also increase the income of MC, Rohtak by
 - Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall also submit the projects to the (m) Government under Divya Nagar Scheme at the earliest.
 - Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall put in efforts for auctioning of advertisement rights through the Portal so that permission charges for display of (n) advertisement can be recovered to enhance the income of MC, Rohtak as there is good potential/scope under this Head in whole municipal area.

Further, the name of the Head will be 'Permission Charges for display of advertisement' instead of 'Advertisement Permission Fee' as mentioned in the

- Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall put in maximum efforts for regularization of unauthorized mobile towers operating within municipal limits and penalty/ (o)
- Municipal Corporation shall ensure that 85 percent of the Budgeted Revenue/ Income targets fixed for F.Y. 2023-24 are achieved otherwise Government may (p) reduce the allotted SFC grant by 20 percent.

Further, disciplinary action will be initiated against the concerned delinquent staff on account of non-achievement of above-mentioned targets.

- Government vide instructions dated 18.08.2022 had directed all the municipalities not to remit 1% share of their annual income to Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Haryana in future. As such the Head i.e., 'Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, Haryana Supervision Charges' is not required in future and shall be removed from the Budget Estimates during F.Y. 2024-25.
 - Municipal Corporation, Rohtak shall submit quarterly reports of actual recovery & expenditure to the Government through Directorate of Urban Local Bodies, (r) Haryana, Panchkula on 5th of every succeeding month of each quarter (i.e., on 5th July, 2023; 5th October, 2023; 5th January, 2024 and 5th April, 2024) at email id:ulbhrybudget@gmail.com.
